Craft your own Flippy fish

GETTING STARTED

- 1 Take the fish template and color your fish with your favourite colors.
- 2 Carefully cut out the fish along the lines. You will have two pieces: the head and the tail.
- 3 Make the fish's belly. Take a long strip of colourful paper. Make sure it fits between the head and the tail.
- 4 Fold the paper back and forth like an accordion (zig-zag) until it is all folded.
- 5 Glue one end of the folded paper to the back of the fish head. Glue the other end to the back of the tail. Now your fish has a stretchy belly!
- 6 Add the sticks. Glue one stick behind the head and one stick behind the tail.
- 7 Wait a few minutes for the glue to dry.
- 8 Time to play! Hold the sticks and pull them apart to make the fish grow long. Push the sticks together to make it small again.


Fun tip: Make a whole family of fish in different colours and sizes!
